










- NCAC's very own High Adventure Camp
















James River Canoe Trek

 - And NCAC Health Advisory

- Usually change camp sites from day to day
- More challenging environments
- Pack much lighter since you carry everything
- Either inside the BSA "Safety Net" or "DIY"

Ways to Go on a High Adventure Trek


- With your Unit
- Through Council-run Contingent Crews
- As an Individual (including OA crews)

High Adventure w/Council Crews

- Many units lack the "critical mass" to conduct their own trek:
 - Not enough age-appropriate Scouts in Unit
 - Lack of Adult Leader HA experience & knowledge
- Consider NCAC HAC "Contingent"/"Provisional" treks:
 - Accept small groups or individuals from these Units
 - Unit crews "leave the nest" after one or more HAC treks
- NCAC HAC handles all planning & logistics plus …

- NCAC HAC offers Training Sessions for
 - Philmont
 - Northern Tier
 - Sea Base
- Philmont Adult Advisor Hike (mandatory for HAC treks)
- Adult Advisors & Crew Leaders <u>from any NCAC crew</u> are always welcome at any NCAC HAC training or to tap into our decades of HA experience!

High Adventure Bases – 2023

- Philmont
 - 12-day, 9-day and 7-day Backpacking Treks, crews of 8–12
 - Cavalcade. Trail Crews, Rayado, ROCS, Ranch Hands, STEM)
- Sea Base
 - 6-day to 9-day Ocean Adventures, crews of 6–8 or 10–12
 - Sailing & Snorkeling, SCUBA, STEM, FL Keys, Bahamas, USVI
- Northern Tier
 - 11-day to 7-day Wilderness Canoeing Treks, crews of 6–8 or 6-11
 - Okpik (winter), Autumn, "Get your Feet Wet" (age 11) Treks
- Summit
 - 7-day Extreme Experiences, crews of 8 (up to 12 for an add'l fee)
 - S-Experience, New River, ATV, Bikepacking, Pack n' Paddle, Marksman
